3 day Katherine river safari

Over three days, this trip covers between 40 and 55 kilometres of wildlife-rich river downstream from the town of Katherine (situated 320 kilometres southeast of Darwin) with accredited, qualified guides and top quality equipment. Participants will discover rocky banks, paperbark forests, small rapids and pandanus channels. There will be comfortable bush camping, great dining, fantastic service, and wildlife encounters.

Travel involves trekking and paddling downriver in a range of sit-on-top kayaks or 2-person canoes. No prior canoeing/kayaking experience is needed. Check out the <u>3 day Katherine river safari</u> for more details on camping, supplies, meals, and what to bring.

The tour requires a minimum of four participants to run and has a maximum capacity of 10 pax.

Itinerary

This custom tour departs from the Darwin Entertainment Centre around 12 pm on Sunday, 1st October 2023. The tour then proceeds to Nitmiluk Gorge for the 3.5 hour Nabilil Dreaming Sunset Dinner Cruise. Following the cruise, participants are taken to accommodation in Katherine. At 7 am the next morning (2nd October), participants are picked up and transferred to the Gecko Canoeing depot for the 3 day Katherine river safari. **The tour transfers back to Darwin on the evening of Wednesday, 4th October, arriving in Darwin around 7 pm**.

Cost: AUD 1,640 per person that includes individual accommodation for the first night (1st October) at Katherine and all meals.
